### The Invicta Shoot: 14 - 15 February 2026 to the Marks, at Speed and in the Cloth of Gold

Godmersham Park is open to the Longbow. The Fraternity's International shoots are by kind permission of the owners of the Godmersham Estate and its Administrator. Built in 1732, it was once the home of Edward Knight, brother to the novelist Jane Austen and served her as an inspiration for Mansfield Park. Since 2017, the House has also featured on the British £10 note.

Close to major transport axes; the M20 Ashford and the M2/A2 Canterbury. A chalk-stream (the Stour) intersects a timeless landscape planted with mature well-maintained trees offering commanding views of the North Downs and Pilgrim's Way.
